

Maka i Hawaii – 30 minutes, a local cultural program from a native Hawaiian perspective featuring Nephi Pomaima'i Brown. The show features local Hawaiian artisans and kapuna.

Hola Paraíso – 30 minutes, a local program for Hawai'i's Hispanic community discussing news, needs and concerns of this growing part of our population (now 13%). The program features interviews with Hispanic leaders and business owners from around our state.

Pilipino Hawai'i – 30 minutes, a program for Hawai'i's Filipino community discussing issues of interest and concern. Local events, festivals and employment opportunities are shared. Business and political leaders from the Filipino community are featured along with music and dance.

Honolulu Diocese - 30 minutes, a local program featuring church leaders discussing the Hawai'i's Catholic Church's news, work and service in the Diocese.

Sisters of Hawai'i – 30 minutes, a local program featuring interviews with Catholic nuns from different orders serving in Hawaii describing their personal callings and every day life.

Homeless 808 – 30 minutes, a local program discussing this growing problem in Hawai'i and what can and is being done about it. It features interviews with individuals and organizations that are making a difference in this critical area and offers opportunity to the viewers as to how they can get involved.

KUPU-TV News - 30 minutes Monday through Friday, a news program featuring local, national and international news followed by news from the Catholic Church and around the world. This program features the Hawai'i Catholic Herald and the Catholic News Agency.

Cathedral of Our Lady of Peace Sunday Mass – 60 minutes, Mass celebrated at the Cathedral of Our Lady of Peace in Honolulu, Hawai'i; the oldest cathedral in the United States.

Samoan Mass from Holy Family – 90 minutes, Mass celebrated in the Samoan language from Holy Family Catholic Church in Honolulu, Hawai'i.

Catholic Mass in Spanish from St. John's – 60 minutes starting September, 2013, Mass celebrated in the Spanish language from St. John the Baptist Parish in Honolulu, Hawai'i.

Samoan Catholic Fellowship and Song – 90 minutes starting September, 2013, a music program featuring the Samoan Choir from Holy Family Catholic Church. This program is celebrated in English and the Samoan language and held at Holy Family Catholic Church in Honolulu, Hawai'i.

Micronesian Catholic Mass from Holy Family – 90 minutes starting October, 2013, Mass celebrated in the Micronesian language and held at Holy Family Catholic Church in Honolulu, Hawai'i.
